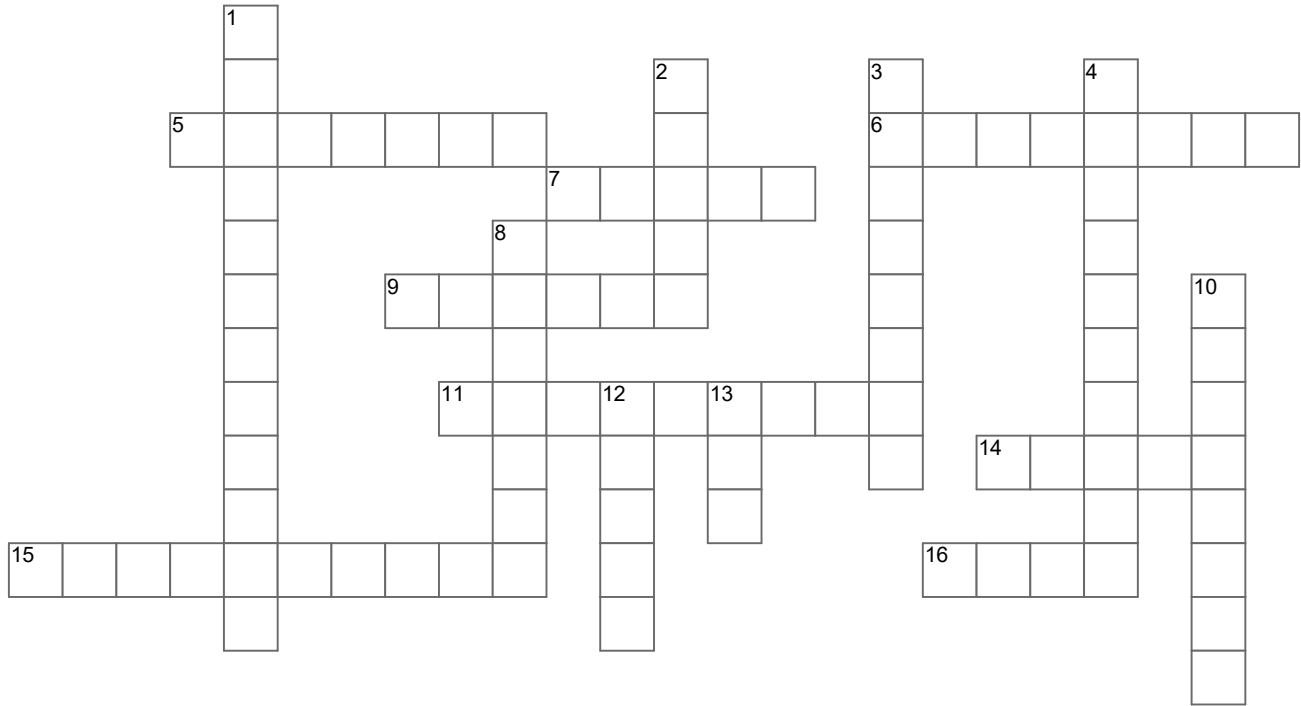

13. Signifies hardiness & valour.

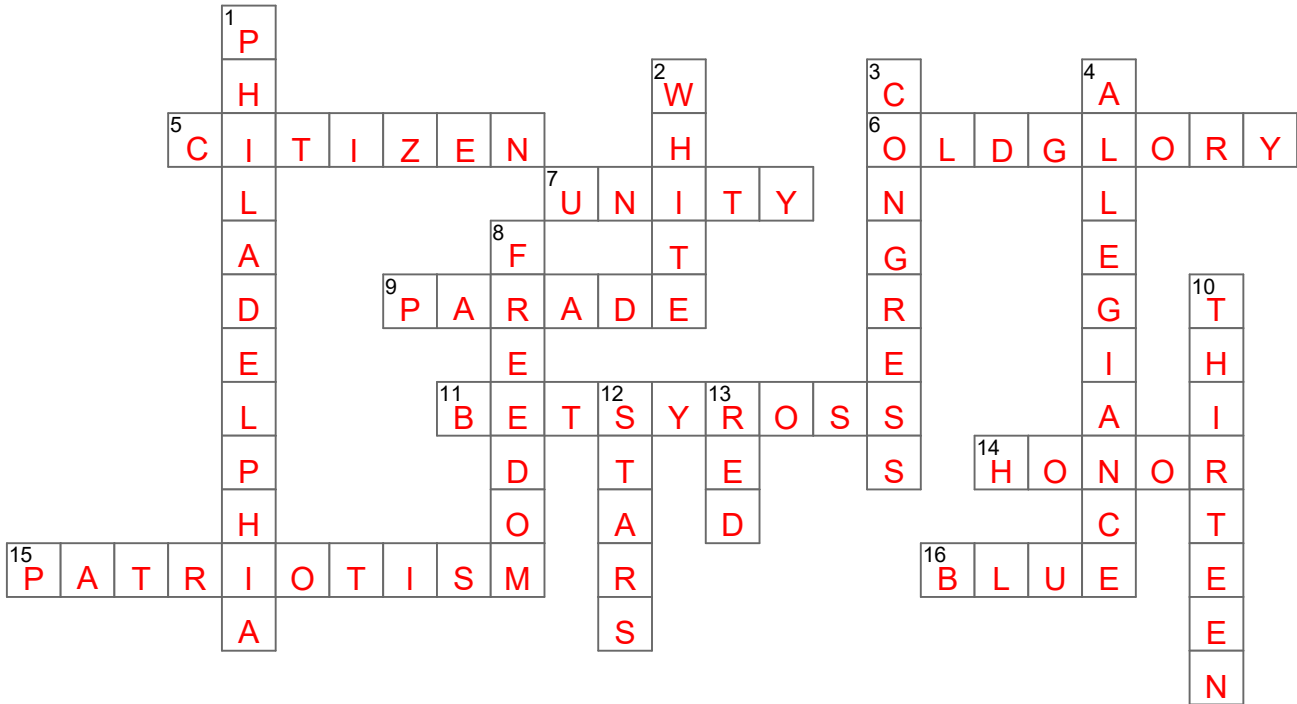
