

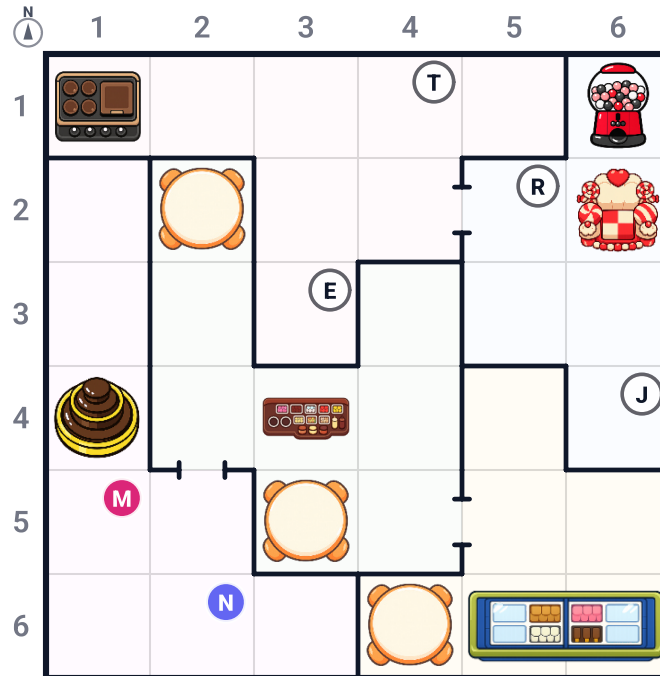
3. One Little Clue, One Great Question

How to solve it

1. **Ethel**: "Guess what! She was in the Fudge Kitchen, in the 3rd row." That can only mean column 3, row 3: the **Fudge Kitchen**.
2. **Ruth**: "Guess what! She was in the 2nd row, in the 5th column." With the others in place, the only cell left for her is column 5, row 2, the **Window Display**.
3. **Jerome**: "His room had a gumball machine in it." With the others in place, the only cell left for him is column 6, row 4, the **Window Display**.
4. **Nell**: "She was 6 squares from the fudge pot, counting the difference in rows plus the difference in columns." With the others in place, the only cell left for her is column 2, row 6, the **Chocolate Corner**.
5. **Townsend**: "There was a fudge pot in his room, but he wasn't next to it." With the others in place, the only cell left for him is column 4, row 1, the **Fudge Kitchen**.
6. **Mittens**: "The lost kitten! Only one friend discovered her hiding spot." With the others in place, the only cell left for her is column 1, row 5, the **Chocolate Corner**.
7. With everyone placed, only **Nell** shares the **Chocolate Corner** with **Mittens**, **Nell** is the answer.
