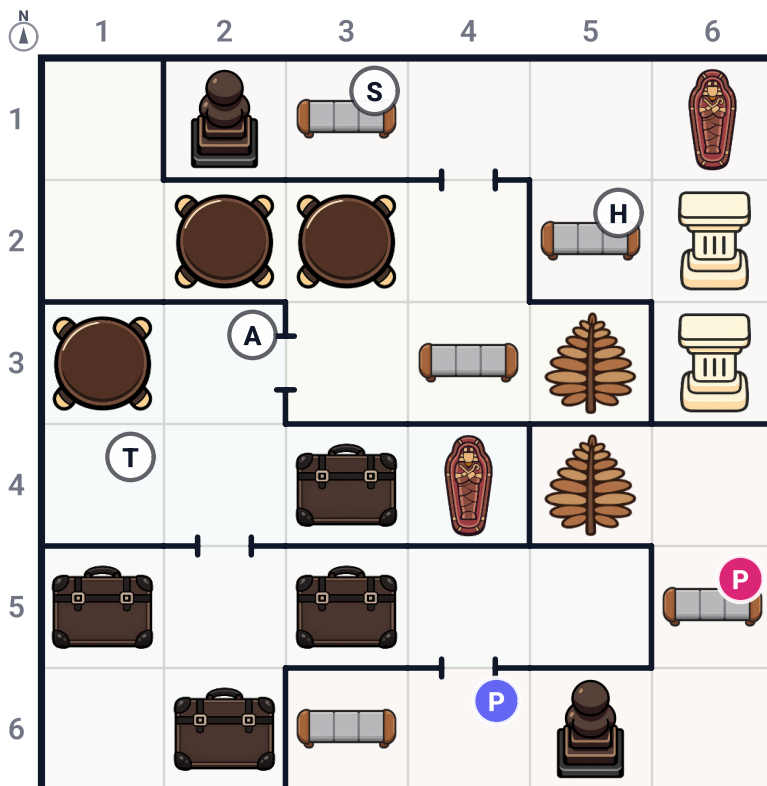

How to solve it

1. **Howard**: "Guess what! He was sitting on a bench, beside a pedestal." That can only mean column 5, row 2: the **Egyptian Wing**.
2. **Penn**: "He was in the Foyer and in the 4th column." With the others in place, the only cell left for him is column 4, row 6, the **Foyer**.
3. **Sara**: "She was not beside a pedestal, but her room held more than one pedestal." With the others in place, the only cell left for her is column 3, row 1, the **Egyptian Wing**.
4. **Ashley**: "She was in the 3rd row, in the 2nd column." With the others in place, the only cell left for her is column 2, row 3, the **Vault**.
5. **Tate**: "He was in the south-west quarter of the floor plan." With the others in place, the only cell left for him is column 1, row 4, the **Vault**.
6. **Poppy**: "The lost kitten! She got found by exactly one clever friend." With the others in place, the only cell left for her is column 6, row 5, the **Foyer**.
7. With everyone placed, only **Penn** shares the **Foyer** with **Poppy**, **Penn** is the answer.
